Paul Norris Higbee, Jr., joined the Office of Legislative Counsel in October of 2015. Since 1997, he has been a member of the State Bar licensed to practice before all trial and appellate courts in Georgia except for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Georgia.

Prior to joining the Office of Legislative Counsel, Mr. Higbee clerked for the Augusta Judicial Circuit Superior Courts domestic relations division and then practiced local government law for 18 years in private practice counseling more than two dozen local governmental entities in the metro Atlanta area and throughout Georgia.

Mr. Higbee received his Juris Doctor degree from the University of Georgia's School of Law, where he served as Executive Notes Editor of the *JOURNAL OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW*, in which he published *Markman v. Westview Instruments: The Jury's Role in Patent Cases*. He also taught a year of freshman English at UGA while obtaining his Master of Arts degree in English between college and law school.

Mr. Higbee earned an Associate of Arts degree from Oxford College of Emory University, as well as the English Department Award and the Jay Hamrick Award for Breaking Down Barriers and Creating a More Caring Community on Campus. Furthermore, he received his Bachelor of Arts degree, with high honors in English, from Emory, which he attended as a Dean's Scholar. He additionally served as a staff writer for the *EMORY WHEEL* newspaper, a resident assistant with campus life, a student government association senator, an English tutor, and Oxford College campus coordinator for Habitat for Humanity. Mr. Higbee is also a proud alumnus of Clinch County High School in Homerville.
