Vince Wiegand came to the Office of Legislative Counsel from the Georgia Department of Insurance in 2018. A member of the State Bar of Georgia since 1995, he served for 14 cumulative years in the department as a staff attorney, senior staff attorney, and division director. Between stints with the department, Mr. Wiegand worked on insurance and other matters in private practice and as an in-house lawyer, company officer, and board member in the life insurance and financial services industries. He returned to the department in 2011, where he focused primarily on drafting the Insurance Commissioner's decisions in contested cases and regulations across all lines of insurance. He also served as the department's hearing officer when the Commissioner was unavailable.

Mr. Wiegand has been awarded the Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter designation by the American Institute for Property Casualty Underwriters and the Accredited Insurance Examiner designation in life insurance and annuities by the Insurance Regulatory Examiners Society.

Mr. Wiegand earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Georgia, a master's degree from Georgia State University, and a Juris Doctor degree from Cumberland School of Law, Samford University. In law school, he served as a student judge on the Moot Court Board, was on the Dean's List, and was selected by faculty as a Legal Research and Writing Teaching Fellow.
