A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Peter G. Livingston on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Peter Livingston of Boy Scout Troop 2000 of Duluth, Georgia has obtained the
3 coveted rank of Eagle Scout; and

4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
5 the Boy Scouts of America; and

6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

9 WHEREAS, Peter, who has held numerous positions of leadership in Troop 2000, has amply
10 demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that he possesses these qualities along with
11 sterling character; and

12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 11 of which are
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 WHEREAS, Peter has met these demanding requirements through diligent effort including
15 an Eagle Scout project in which he led fellow Scouts in a Bike Safety Fair at Medlock Bridge
16 Elementary School; and

17 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Peter has brought honor not only to himself but
18 also to his family and troop.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize and commend Peter G. Livingston for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the
