A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

examination of applicants for drivers' licenses, so as to authorize licensed driver training
instructors to act as driver's license examiners; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

Code Section 40-5-27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to examination of
applicants for drivers' licenses, is amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting in lieu
thereof the following:

SECTION 1.

10 "(b)(1) The department shall make provision for giving an examination either in the 11 county where the applicant resides or at another place reasonably convenient to the 12 applicant. The examination, with the exception of those required for a commercial 13 driver's license, commercial driver's license permit, or noncommercial Class A, B, or M 14 license, shall be given at least once each month in each county of the state.

15 (2) The on-the-road driving test portion of an examination, when applicable, may be

16 <u>administered either by a department employee appointed for such purpose or, pursuant</u>

17 to contract with the department, by a driver training instructor who is licensed under

18 Chapter 13 of Title 43 to provide instruction for the class of license which the applicant

19 seeks. In the event that a licensed driver training instructor administers such on-the-road

20 <u>driving test, the results shall be reported to the department in accordance with rules or</u>

21 regulations promulgated thereby, and the licensed driver training instructor shall not

22 receive any compensation from the department but may charge the applicant a fee,

23 payable to the driver training instructor, of not more than \$50.00 for administering such

24 <u>test.</u>"
