A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 5 of Chapter 5 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to earned-time allowances and work incentive credits, so as to amend the provisions
- 3 for the work incentive program; to authorize the Department of Corrections to create a work
- 4 incentive program; to provide for the practices and procedures connected with such program;
- 5 to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 5 of Chapter 5 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 earned-time allowances and work incentive credits, is amended by striking Code Section
- 10 42-5-101, relating to work incentive credits, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new
- 11 Code Section 42-5-101 to read as follows:
- 12 "42-5-101.
- 13 (a) The Department of Corrections is authorized to devise and to provide by agency rule
- 14 a system of work incentive credits which may be awarded program administered by the
- department to for persons committed to its custody for any felony prison term other than
- life imprisonment.
- 17 (b) The work Work incentive credits may be awarded program will be administered by the
- department to recognize inmates' institutional attainments in academic or vocational
- education, satisfactory performance of work assignments made by the penal institution, and
- 20 compliance with satisfactory behavior standards established by the department.
- 21 (c) The department may award up to one day of work incentive credits for each day during
- 22 which the subject inmate has participated in approved educational or other counseling
- 23 programs, has satisfactorily performed work tasks assigned by the penal institution, and has
- 24 complied with satisfactory behavior standards established by the department.
- 25 (d) Sufficient successful participation in any such Any work incentive credits awarded
- 26 <u>program by</u> an inmate by the department shall be reported by the department to the State

1 Board of Pardons and Paroles which shall consider such <u>credits participation</u> when making

- 2 a final parole release decision regarding the subject inmate. The department is authorized
- 3 to recommend the board apply consider the participation in the work incentive credits
- 4 <u>program</u> to advance any tentative parole release date already established for the subject
- 5 inmate.
- 6 (e)(d) The department also shall report to the State Board of Pardons and Paroles the cases
- of inmates who decline or refuse to participate in work, educational, or counseling
- 8 programs, who or who participate but fail to comply with satisfactory behavior standards,
- 9 and who therefore refuse to earn work incentive credits."

SECTION 2.

- 11 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 12 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
