A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to students, so as to change a provision allowing discretionary modification of a
- 3 requirement to expel a student who brings a weapon to school; to repeal conflicting laws, and
- 4 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 students, is amended by striking in its entirety Code Section 20-2-751.1, relating to
- 9 disciplinary policies for students bringing weapons to school, and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 10 following:

- 11 "20-2-751.1.
- 12 (a) Each local board of education shall establish a policy requiring the expulsion from
- school for a period of not less than one calendar year of any student who is determined,
- pursuant to this subpart, to have brought a weapon to school.
- 15 (b) The local board of education <u>or its designee</u> shall have the authority to modify such
- 16 expulsion requirement as provided in subsection (a) of this Code section on a case-by-case
- basis including but not limited to instances in which a hearing officer, tribunal, panel,
- 18 <u>superintendent, local board of education, or other designee of a local board of education</u>
- 19 <u>finds that the student who brought the weapon to school had no intent to harm or threaten</u>
- any other person.
- 21 (c) A hearing officer, tribunal, panel, superintendent, or local board of education shall be
- authorized to place a student determined to have brought a weapon to school in an
- 23 alternative educational setting.
- 24 (d) Nothing in this Code section shall infringe on any right provided to students with
- 25 Individualized Education Programs pursuant to the federal Individuals with Disabilities
