## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to loitering at or disrupting schools, so as to provide additional discretion to local
- 3 school boards regarding exceptions to the prohibition against possession of electronic
- 4 communication devices by students in school; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 27 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 loitering at or disrupting schools, is amended by striking Code Section 20-2-1183, relating
- 10 to possession of electronic communication devices by students at school, and inserting in lieu
- 11 thereof the following:
- *"*20-2-1183.
- 13 (a) No local board of education shall permit any pupil to carry a pocket pager or electronic
- communication device in school except for health or other <del>unusual reasons approved by</del>
- 15 the board of education reasons, including but not limited to safety of a student or students.
- Exceptions other than health or safety shall be listed in the written policies of a local board
- of education. A local board of education may also grant exceptions on a case-by-case
- 18 <u>basis</u>.
- 19 (b) Any student found in violation of the provisions of this Code section shall be subject
- 20 to placement in an alternative education program."

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
