A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to penal institutions,
2	so as to require the Georgia Bureau of Investigation to notify all elementary and secondary
3	schools and day-care and group day-care centers within a county of the names and addresses
4	of all registered sexual offenders residing within such county; to provide for related matters;
5	to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to penal institutions, is amended
9	in Code Section 42-1-12, relating to the State Sexual Offender Registry, by striking in its
10	entirety subsection (c) and inserting in its place the following:

11 "(c) The appropriate state official shall, within three days after receipt of information described in paragraph (3) of subsection (b) of this Code section, forward such information 12 to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. The Georgia Bureau of Investigation shall notify 13 14 all elementary and secondary schools and day-care and group day-care centers within a county of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders residing within such 15 county. Once the data is entered into the criminal justice information system by the 16 appropriate state official or sheriff, the Georgia Crime Information Center, where 17 appropriate, shall immediately notify the sheriff of the person's county of residence, either 18 19 permanent or temporary, the sheriff of the county of employment, and the sheriff of the 20 county where the person attends school. The Georgia Bureau of Investigation shall also 21 immediately transmit the conviction data and fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of 22 Investigation. It shall be the duty of the sheriff of each county within this state to maintain a register of the names and addresses of all registered offenders within the sheriff's 23 jurisdiction whose names have been provided by the Georgia Bureau of Investigation to 24 25 the sheriff under this Code section. The Georgia Bureau of Investigation shall establish operating policies and procedures concerning record ownership, quality, verification, 26

- 1 modification, and cancellation and shall perform mail out and verification duties on a
- 2 quarterly basis. The Georgia Bureau of Investigation shall send each month criminal justice
- 3 information system network messages to sheriffs listing offenders due for verification. The
- 4 bureau shall also create a photo image file from original entries and provide such entries
- 5 to sheriffs to assist in offender identification and verification."

SECTION 2.

7 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
