A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Col. Samuel E. Evans; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Col. Samuel E. Evans of Kennesaw, Georgia, retired from the U.S. Air Force
3 in December, 2001, after having completed more than 30 years of distinguished service to
4 the nation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was born in Birmingham, Alabama, graduated from Miles College in
6 business administration, enlisted in the Air Force in September, 1971, and was selected for
7 officer training school and commissioned a second lieutenant in April, 1973; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was a most capable and dedicated officer whose military decorations include
9 the Defense Superior Service Medal (two awards), Air Force Meritorious Service Medal (six
10 awards), and the Air Force Commendation Award; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he served as Commander, Defense Contract Management Agency Lockheed
12 Martin Marietta for the past three years where he led an 80 person organization responsible
13 for on-site contract administration services for the government work performed at Lockheed
14 Martin Aeronautics Company in Marietta; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he directed oversight of more than 1,800 contracts with a total face value of
16 \$29.8 billion, including the F-22 Raptor, C-130J Hercules aircraft, and modification of the
17 C-5 Galaxy fleet as well as spare parts support for the P-3 Orion and ES-3A Sentry.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Col. Samuel E. Evans on his exemplary military service career and
20 convey to him their best wishes for health and happiness in his retirement.
