- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Bob Lenox; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Robert L. (Bob) Lenox was born on July 20, 1944, in Fort Sill, Oklahoma,
3 during his father's service as a WWII artillery officer; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he grew up in Cincinnati and Cleveland, Ohio, where he attended St. Ignatius
5 High School and received a degree in Finance and Accounting from Baldwin-Wallace
6 College; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Lenox began his professional career with Harris Corp. of Dayton, Ohio, and
8 served as Credit Manager, Manager of European Operations, and National Sales Manager
9 for the company; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he founded Continuous Forms and Checks in Peachtree City, Georgia, in 1982
11 and this highly successful company has grown to employ more than 400 people and exceeds
12 \$50 million in annual sales; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Lenox was elected Mayor of Peachtree City in 1991 and has recently
14 completed his third and final term of office as mayor; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he has been an exemplary public servant and presided over many civic
16 achievements for Peachtree City, including, among others, the acquisition of the local
17 sewerage system and the successful recruitment of new industry to the area; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is fitting that this body express to Mr. Lenox its appreciation for his many
19 vital and important contributions to his community and the State of Georgia.
