A RESOLUTION

1 Compensating Ms. Valerie Louise Hamby; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 27, 1999, Ms. Valerie Louise Hamby, a resident of Doraville,
3 Georgia, was driving her 1991 Chevrolet Camaro on Georgia Highway 369 toward
4 Gainesville College; and

5 WHEREAS, apparently a Department of Transportation truck and crew were painting a
6 white line on a portion of Georgia Highway 369; and

7 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation employees had not set out any cones or
8 warning devices to alert motorists of its work; and

9 WHEREAS, as Ms. Hamby followed the Department of Transportation truck behind a line
10 of motor vehicles and subsequently passed the truck, the right side of her motor vehicle was
11 damaged as a result of being coated with white paint; and

12 WHEREAS, Ms. Hamby has suffered unreimbursed property damage to her motor vehicle
13 totaling \$919.78; and

14 WHEREAS, the loss occurred through no fault or negligence on the part of Ms. Hamby and
15 it is only fitting and proper that she be compensated for her loss.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 GEORGIA that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to pay the sum
18 of \$919.78 to Ms. Valerie Louise Hamby as compensation as provided above. Said sum shall
19 be paid from funds appropriated to or available to said Department of Transportation and
20 shall be in full and complete satisfaction of all claims against the state arising out of said
21 occurrence.
