A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Congress of the United States to amend Title XXI of the federal Social Security
- 2 Act to remove exclusions which prohibit expansion of the PeachCare for Kids Program under
- 3 Code Section 49-5-273 to cover children of public school employees; and for other purposes.
- WHEREAS, paragraph (2) of subsection (b) of 42 U.S.C. Section 1397(jj) of Title XXI of the federal Social Security Act provides an exclusion with respect to children who are members of a family eligible for health benefits coverage under a state health benefit plan on the basis of a family by member's employment with a public agency in the state; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the direct result of this federal restriction is that in this state the PeachCare for
 9 Kids Program under Code Section 49-5-273 cannot be expanded to cover children of public
 10 school employees; and
- WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these federal restrictions be amendedappropriately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that the United States Congress is urged to take all necessary steps to amend Title XXI of the federal Social Security Act to remove exclusions which prohibit expansion of the PeachCare for Kids Program under Code Section 49-5-273 to cover children of public school employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each member of the United
States Congress representing the State of Georgia.
