

Senate Bill 348

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend Code Section 40-6-20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to enforcement of traffic-control device obedience requirements by means of traffic-control signal monitoring devices, so as to redefine a term; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Code Section 40-6-20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to enforcement of traffic-control device obedience requirements by means of traffic-control signal monitoring devices, is amended by striking subparagraph (f)(1)(B) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"(B) 'Recorded images' means images recorded by a traffic-control signal monitoring device:

(i) On:

(I) Two or more photographs;

(II) Two or more microphotographs;

(III) Two or more electronic images; or

(IV) Videotape; and

(ii) Showing a traffic-control signal displaying a CIRCULAR RED or RED ARROW signal along with the view from the rear only of a motor vehicle apparently operated in disregard or disobedience of such signal and, on at least one such image or portion of tape, clearly revealing the number or other identifying designation of the license plate displayed on the rear of such motor vehicle."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
