## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to student health, so as to change certain provisions relating to rules and
- 3 regulations for nutritional screening and eye, ear, and dental examinations of students; to
- 4 provide that such eye examinations shall be performed by ophthalmologists or optometrists;
- 5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to student health, is amended by striking Code Section 20-2-770, relating to rules and
- 10 regulations for nutritional screening and eye, ear, and dental examinations of students, and
- inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 13 The Department of Human Resources is authorized and directed, in cooperation with the
- 14 State Board of Education, to promulgate rules and regulations to provide for a nutritional
- screening and eye, ear, and dental examinations for each student entering the first grade in
- the public schools of this state and at such other times as such rules and regulations shall
- provide. Such rules and regulations shall provide procedures for <u>eye examinations to be</u>
- 18 <u>performed by ophthalmologists or optometrists, for</u> local boards of health to provide for
- such <u>ear and dental</u> examinations and <u>nutritional</u> screenings, and for the issuance of a
- 20 certificate to the parent or parents of children entering the first grade indicating that such

examinations and screenings have been made, and such certificates shall be turned in to the

- school officials at the time of enrollment. Such rules and regulations shall further provide
- that the examinations and screenings required in this Code section may be made by private
- practitioners and authorize the certification provided for in this Code section by such
- 25 private practitioners."
