A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to retirement and
2 pensions, so as to correct typographical, stylistic, and other errors and omissions in Title 47
3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and in Acts of the General Assembly amending
4 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to correct capitalization and spelling in
5 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to provide for other matters relative to
6 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to provide an effective date; to repeal
7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to retirement and pensions, is
11 amended as follows:

12 (1) By striking "Title 2" and inserting in its place "Title 12" in subsection (a) of Code
13 Section 47-2-317, relating to membership in the retirement system of officers and employees
14 of the Georgia Agrirama Development Authority.

15 (2) By striking subparagraph (H) of paragraph (5) of Code Section 47-17-1, relating to
16 definitions in regard to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, and inserting in lieu
17 thereof the following:

18 ~~"(H) Any person employed by the Public Service Commission who was designated by~~
19 ~~such commission as an enforcement officer pursuant to former Code Section 46-7-70~~
20 ~~as it existed under the "Motor Carrier Act of 1931," as amended, or who is designated~~
21 ~~by such commission as an enforcement officer pursuant to Code Section 46-7-28 and~~
22 ~~who is required by the terms of his or her employment to devote full time to his or her~~
23 ~~job as a law enforcer, and any supervisor of such employees who himself or herself is~~
24 ~~assigned by the terms of his or her employment to have arrest powers and to enforce the~~
25 ~~public utility laws administered by the Public Service Commission; provided, however,~~
26 ~~that such enforcement officers shall be entitled to creditable service toward retirement~~

~~only for membership service rendered after July 1, 1981, and only for membership service which is rendered in such capacity prior to July 1, 2001~~ Reserved;"

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
