A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 32-6-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 stopping vehicles for purposes of weighing, measuring or inspecting, reports of violations,
3 and refusal to stop, so as to change certain provisions relating to refusal to stop; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 32-6-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to stopping
8 vehicles for purposes of weighing, measuring or inspecting, reports of violations, and refusal
9 to stop, is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (b) and inserting in lieu thereof
10 the following:

11 "(b)(1) If the operator of the vehicle shall refuse to stop upon proper order ~~as directed by~~
12 ~~a person authorized by subsection (a) of this Code section~~ to stop, weigh, measure, or
13 inspect the vehicle or its load as directed by a sign, signal, marking, or other traffic
14 control device or by a person authorized by subsection (a) of this Code section, the
15 operator shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished
16 by a fine not to exceed \$200.00. The operator shall have the right to post an appropriate
17 bond, which shall not exceed \$400.00, when any law enforcement officer or employee
18 of the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety authorized to enforce this article apprehends
19 said operator for any violation of this article."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
