A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the League of Women Voters of Atlanta-Fulton County and recognizing
2 January 29, 2002, as League of Women Voters of Atlanta-Fulton County Day at the state
3 capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Atlanta-Fulton County is well known and
5 widely respected as one of the most beneficial and influential political organizations in the
6 state where it exerts a positive influence on government at all levels and promotes voter
7 education, registration, and participation; and

8 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded on February 14, 1920, as a
9 volunteer, nonpartisan organization that fosters political responsibility through informed and
10 active participation of citizens in their government; and

11 WHEREAS, the Atlanta-Fulton County League has continuously and consistently advocated
12 responsible and responsive government and has been a major resource for public education
13 providing a knowledge base so essential for sound citizen political participation; and

14 WHEREAS, the commitment and dedication of the members of the League of Women
15 Voters of Atlanta-Fulton County have been well demonstrated and its accomplishments
16 reflect the value of active, informed citizens in a representative government; and

17 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the citizens and elected officials of the State of
18 Georgia recognize the outstanding contributions of this fine public interest organization.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 this body commends the efforts and success of the League of Women Voters of Atlanta-
21 Fulton County and designates Tuesday, January 29, 2002, as League of Women Voters
22 Atlanta-Fulton County Day at the state capitol.
