A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Henry Grady Jarrard; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Henry Grady Jarrard of Gainesville, Georgia, was a highly respected land
3 surveyor and local businessman who will be long remembered by his wide circle of friends,
4 associates, and fellow citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was born on June 9, 1929, in Cleveland to Hassie Autry and Henry W.
6 Jarrard; graduated from Lyman Hall High School; attended the University of Georgia; served
7 in the United States Army in 1947 and 1948; and was reactivated in 1951 as a member of the
8 US Army Reserves to serve another 13 months during the Korean Conflict; and
- 9 WHEREAS, after his return to civilian life, he learned the surveying trade, established his
10 own company in 1958 that he actively managed for the rest of his life, and built a reputation
11 as one of the most respected land surveyors in the field; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was a passionate hunter and fisherman who was happiest spending time in
13 the outdoors and sharing his enthusiasm and deep love of nature with his children and
14 grandchildren who were a source of great pride and joy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a wonderful, knowledgeable, compassionate man whose love for his
16 family and friends was evident in his lifetime of service and in all his pursuits.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body express regret at the passing of Henry Grady Jarrard and convey
19 their sympathy to his beloved companion and family.
