A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Alexander Kramer Perrin Crumpler on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alex Crumpler of Troop 232 will be awarded, on February 4, 2002, the rank
4 of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
6 the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
8 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capacities that will be of
9 immense benefit throughout life; and

10 WHEREAS, only one Scout out of 1000 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
11 Alex Crumpler has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various
12 special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and

13 WHEREAS, in addition, Alex Crumpler has been a member of the Holy Innocents' Episcopal
14 School Varsity Basketball team, and has enthusiastically devoted his time and energy to
15 numerous extracurricular activities and community service programs; and

16 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Alex Crumpler has brought honor not only to
17 himself but also to his family and troop.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Alexander Kramer Perrin Crumpler for his diligence and dedication
20 in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him
21 on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
