A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 27-3-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 unlawful enticement of game, so as to provide that it shall be lawful to place, expose, deposit,
3 distribute, or scatter any corn, wheat, or other grains, apples, or other feeds as a lure for deer
4 on privately owned lands in the area designated as the southern zone for establishing deer
5 season; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 27-3-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the unlawful
9 enticement of game, is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:

10 "(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section, it shall be lawful
11 to place, expose, deposit, distribute, or scatter any corn, wheat, or other grains, apples, or
12 other feeds so as to constitute a lure or attraction or enticement for deer on privately owned
13 lands in the area designated as the southern zone for establishing deer season."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
