

House Bill 1134

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners for Tattnall County, approved August  
2 18, 1927 (Ga. L. 1927, p. 674), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 20, 1990  
3 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4207), so as to change certain provisions relating to expense supplements  
4 of the chairman and members of the board of commissioners; to provide for an effective date;  
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating a board of commissioners for Tattnall County, approved August 18, 1927  
9 (Ga. L. 1927, p. 674), as amended particularly by an Act approved March 20, 1990 (Ga. L.  
10 1990, p. 4207), is amended by striking subsection (i) of Section 1A and inserting in its place  
11 a new subsection (i) to read as follows:

12 "(i) Salaries and expenses. Commissioners shall receive as compensation for their services  
13 as commissioners the sum of \$350.00 per month. The chairperson shall receive as  
14 compensation for his or her services the sum of \$650.00. In addition to the monthly  
15 salaries provided in this subsection, each commissioner shall receive an expense  
16 supplement in the sum of \$400.00 per month and the chairperson shall receive an expense  
17 supplement in the sum of \$500.00 per month. The expense supplement is an addition to  
18 all salaries and shall cover the costs of expenses incurred by said commissioners during the  
19 performance of their duties of office. Upon approval by a majority vote of the board of  
20 commissioners, the chairperson shall also be furnished a motor vehicle for use in carrying  
21 out the duties of his or her office. The cost of such motor vehicle and the reasonable  
22 expenses of operating and maintaining such motor vehicle shall be paid from county funds.  
23 The chairperson may allow any member of the board of commissioners to use such motor  
24 vehicle in carrying out the duties of such member's office. No other form of compensation  
25 or benefit, either directly or indirectly, shall be received by a commissioner, including the

1 chairperson, for the performance of his or her official duties as a county commissioner of  
2 Tattnall County."

3 **SECTION 2.**

4 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2003.

5 **SECTION 3.**

6 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
