A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Matthew Wilson; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the National 4-H Conference is conducted by the 4-H Youth Development
3 Program of the Extension Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, the
4 National 4-H Council, and the Extension Services of the land grant universities; and

5 WHEREAS, the National 4-H Conference is designated as the premier assembly of 4-H
6 members from throughout the nation to assist Cooperative Extension Service staff in program
7 planning; and
