A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Casey Mull; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Casey Mull of Clarke County is an outstanding member of 4-H and is the
3 recipient of the prestigious College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences Dean's
4 Project Award in Citizenship; and

5 WHEREAS, 4-H Clubs of Georgia provide a unique educational opportunity for students
6 from nine to 19 years of age to learn valuable lessons outside the classroom and offer some
7 55 project areas in which students can develop expertise and compete with one another; and
