A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Edward Morey; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on January 6, 2001, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the tragic and untimely passing of Edward Morey; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, and fine
5 leadership in all his duties throughout his life especially in his service to Fulton County as
6 a member and chairperson of the planning commission and to Sandy Springs as chairman of
7 the Sandy Springs Community Planning Council and as president of the Spalding Woods
8 Civic Association; and
- 9 WHEREAS, this courageous patriot served his country with honor and distinction as a
10 member of the United States Navy Engineering Corps during World War II and the Korean
11 Conflict; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was a pious and devout man who labored ceaselessly in humble service to
13 God as a founding and active parishioner of St. Jude the Apostle Catholic Church; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, kind, and devoted family man leaves an
15 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Edward Morey.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
