A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions relative to state property, so as to prohibit the naming or
- 3 renaming of state property for any living elected state or local public official; to provide an
- 4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 16 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 general provisions relative to state property, is amended by adding at the end thereof a new
- 9 Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "50-16-20.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'state agency' means any branch, department,
- agency, board, bureau, commission, authority, or other unit of state government, by
- whatever name called.
- 14 (b) On and after July 1, 2002, no property owned by the state including, but not limited to,
- parks, highways, roads, streets, bridges, bodies of water, buildings, structures, facilities,
- or other geographical landmarks shall be officially designated or redesignated by any state
- agency or state official by the name and in honor of any living elected state or local public
- official, and no signs or markers shall be erected which so designate any such state owned
- 19 property."
- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002.
- SECTION 3.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
