## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Principals' Collaboratives of Houston County; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Houston County School System has proven itself to be on the cutting edge  
3 of modern educational practices with the formation of two Principal Collaboratives, the  
4 Northside Principals' Collaborative and the Partners for Perry Schools Collaborative; and

5 WHEREAS, the purpose of these collaboratives is to identify needs of students which, if  
6 unfilled, lead to underachievement and dropout; and

7 WHEREAS, at-risk students are identified and given the assistance they need to stay in  
8 school and succeed, while higher achieving students are given the recognition and  
9 encouragement to continue their progress; and

10 WHEREAS, the programs are designed as a local, grass roots effort to provide a better  
11 educational environment for all students of all backgrounds, needs, and abilities to ensure  
12 that no child is left behind in the Houston County School System.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body commend the members of the Houston County Board of Education  
15 and the supervisors, teachers, and employees of the schools of the system for their innovation  
16 and their efforts on behalf of all students.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
18 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the chairperson of the  
19 Houston County Board of Education on behalf of all persons involved in the Houston County  
20 Northside Principals' Collaborative and the Partners for Perry Schools Collaborative.
