

## House Resolution 914

## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the League of Women Voters of Georgia and recognizing February 20, 2002,  
2 as League of Women Voters Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Georgia is well known and widely respected  
4 as one of the most beneficial and influential political organizations in the state where it exerts  
5 a positive influence on government at all levels and promotes voter education, registration,  
6 and participation; and

7 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded on February 14, 1920, as a  
8 volunteer, nonpartisan organization that fosters political responsibility through informed and  
9 active participation of citizens in their government; and

10 WHEREAS, the Georgia League has continuously and consistently advocated responsible  
11 and responsive government and has been a major resource for public education providing a  
12 knowledge base so essential for sound citizen political participation; and

13 WHEREAS, the commitment and dedication of the League of Women Voters and its many  
14 members throughout the state have been well demonstrated and its accomplishments reflect  
15 the value of active, informed citizens in a representative government; and

16 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the citizens and elected officials of the State of  
17 Georgia recognize the outstanding contributions of this fine public interest organization.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 this body commends the efforts and success of the League of Women Voters of Georgia and  
20 designates February 20, 2002, as League of Women Voters Day at the state capitol.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
22 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the organization.
