- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Mrs. Pat Summers; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mrs. Pat Summers devoted the majority of her life to her community and was
3 always known as a superb educator; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she received a bachelor's degree in education and home economics from
5 Tennessee Tech University in 1962 and a master's degree from Georgia College and State
6 University in 1976, and she was awarded a counseling certification at the master's level from
7 Fort Valley State University in 1985; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she was employed by the Houston County School System for 30 years, and she
9 taught mathematics, science, and home economics in the public schools, taught short term
10 adult education courses, and served as a counselor at Northside High School in Houston
11 County from 1986 until her retirement in 1995; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Summers served on the Houston County Board of Education and was
13 recently elected to the position of vice chairperson, and she served as president of the
14 Houston County Retired Teachers' Association; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was active in community activities, having served the Centerville United
16 Methodist Church as a Sunday school teacher, vacation Bible school director, lay ministry
17 leader, administrative board chair, and board of trustees chair; and
- 18 WHEREAS, is only fitting and proper that the members of this body commend this dedicated
19 Georgian.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body express regret at the passing of Mrs. Pat Summers and convey
22 condolences to her grieving family and friends.
