

House Resolution 927

### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Nationwide Civic Action Program; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Nationwide Insurance Company has established the Civic Action Program  
3 (CAP) in each of the states in which Nationwide conducts business. CAP was founded in  
4 1978 and is a nonpartisan organization comprised of people from all facets of the Nationwide  
5 community; and

6 WHEREAS, the employees, retirees, and agents of Nationwide have found a voice in CAP  
7 to express their concerns to their respective state legislatures on matters relating to insurance;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, CAP activities are organized through state committees. Each committee elects  
10 its own officers and plans forums and other special events designed to foster the exchange  
11 of ideas between members and political officials; and

12 WHEREAS, CAP committees also sponsor trips to state capitols and issue workshops  
13 designed to educate members on legislative issues important to the insurance industry,  
14 because knowledge is power in a democratic society; and

15 WHEREAS, the Nationwide CAP program has over 12,500 members who participate in  
16 national mail and telephone campaigns when a legislative issue of concern arises. The  
17 strength of the CAP program, along with Nationwide's well respected government affairs  
18 unit, makes it possible for the collective voice of agents, employees, and retirees of  
19 Nationwide to be heard on important legislation that impacts Nationwide and its  
20 policyholders.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
22 the members of this body recognize the Nationwide Civic Action Program and commend its  
23 participants for their contributions.
