- 2 WHEREAS, on January 6, 2001, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the tragic and untimely passing of Edward Morey; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was an honest and dedicated man who strived for excellence in all his
5 endeavors; and
- 6 WHEREAS, this beloved individual exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding
7 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties throughout his life
8 especially in his service to Fulton County as a member and chairperson of the planning
9 commission and to Sandy Springs as a tireless and knowledgeable community advocate; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this courageous patriot served his country with honor and distinction as a
11 member of the United States Navy Engineering Corps during World War II and the Korean
12 Conflict; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was a pious and devout man who labored ceaselessly in humble service to
14 God as a founding and active parishioner of St. Jude the Apostle Catholic Church; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
18 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens
19 of his community and state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
20 associates; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, kind, and devoted family man leaves an
22 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of
3 Edward Morey.
