

House Bill 245

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to employment, so as to provide for an exemption from the requirement
3 to pay the state supplement for local school principals in one separate payment each school
4 year in certain circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to employment, is amended by striking in its entirety Code Section 20-2-214,
10 relating to principals' salary schedule and supplements, and inserting in lieu thereof the
11 following:

12 "20-2-214.

13 The State Board of Education shall establish a salary schedule for school principals that
14 includes a supplement amount for each principal. The amount of the supplement shall be
15 based on the amount appropriated by the General Assembly for this purpose each year
16 divided by the total weighted full-time equivalent count for the state. The amount for each
17 principal shall be determined by multiplying the amount per weighted full-time equivalent
18 count by the weighted full-time equivalent count for each school. Local school systems
19 shall pay this supplement to each local school principal in one separate payment each
20 school year; provided, however, that any local school system which demonstrates to the
21 State Department of Education proof of paying to each of its school principals the full
22 amount of the state supplement for such school principal for the previous school year shall
23 be exempt from the requirement of paying the state supplement in one separate payment
24 and may divide the state supplement equally into a part for each periodic payment to school
25 principals and add each such part to each of the local school system's regular periodic
26 payments to each school principal."
