A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-3-621 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 prohibited acts as to archeological, aboriginal, prehistoric, or historic sites, notification of
- 3 the state archeologist before beginning the investigation or disturbance of a site, and
- 4 penalties, so as to provide an exemption from the prohibition against disturbing certain
- 5 submerged archeological, aboriginal, prehistoric, or historic sites; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 6 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 12-3-621 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prohibited acts
- 10 as to archeological, aboriginal, prehistoric, or historic sites, notification of the state
- 11 archeologist before beginning the investigation or disturbance of a site, and penalties, is
- amended by striking in its entirety paragraph (2) of subsection (a) and inserting in lieu
- 13 thereof the following:
- 14 "(2) Disturb or alter in any manner the prevailing condition of any archeological,
- aboriginal, prehistoric, or historic site; provided, however, that except for human remains
- and burial objects, this paragraph shall not apply to the collecting of artifacts exposed on
- the surface of dry land; <u>and provided, further, that this paragraph shall not apply to the</u>
- 18 <u>collecting of isolated submerged finds such as artifacts that have become displaced from</u>
- 19 <u>their archeological context because of erosion or water currents and are not considered</u>
- 20 <u>of primary archeological significance because they have become isolated from their sites</u>

of origin and are not within an archeological, aboriginal, prehistoric, or historic site, so

- 22 long as the collection of such isolated submerged finds is reported to the department in
- 23 such manner as specified by the department;"

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
