A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 52-7-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
classification of vessels and required equipment, so as to provide for required lifesaving
equipment on certain vessels; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.** 6 Code Section 52-7-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to classification of 7 vessels and required equipment, is amended by striking in its entirety paragraph (1) of 8 subsection (d) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 9 "(1) Every vessel shall be equipped with and carry aboard, at all times, at least one Type 10 I, II, III, or V (hybrid) personal flotation device for each person on board; provided, 11 however, Type V (hybrid) devices are acceptable only when worn and securely fastened. 12 In addition to the individual personal flotation device, each vessel, except for personal watercraft, as such term is defined in subsection (a) of Code Section 52-7-8.2, 16 feet or 13 14 more in length, other than canoes, and kayaks, must at all times be equipped with at least 15 one Type IV (throwable) device."
