A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 15-6-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the recordation and index of military service records, so as to provide that certain military records recorded in the superior courts shall be kept under lock; to provide for persons who may review and receive certified copies of such records; to provide for procedures; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1. of the Official Code of Georgia Annotat

8 Code Section 15-6-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the recordation 9 and index of military service records, is amended by inserting at the end thereof the 10 following:

"(c) The documents identified in subsection (a) of this Code section shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose and properly indexed; and the book shall be part of the records of the court in which such documents were recorded. All such records, including the index shall be kept sealed and locked. The records may be examined by the party recording such records or his or her spouse or attorney, and such persons may receive a certified copy of such records, upon written petition presented to the court and the court having entered a finding that the petitioner is entitled to review and receive a certified copy of the records."
