A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act creating the State Court of Cobb County, approved March 26, 1964 (Ga.
- 2 L. 1964, p. 3211), as amended, so as to change the compensation of the judges and associate
- 3 judges of the state court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act creating the State Court of Cobb County approved March 26, 1964 (Ga. L. 1964, p.
- 8 3211), as amended, is amended by striking from Section 3 the following:
- 9 "The chief judge of the State Court of Cobb County shall receive as additional
- 10 compensation \$3,800.00 per annum.",
- and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 12 "The chief judge of the State Court of Cobb County shall receive as additional
- compensation \$3,952.00 per annum."
- 14 SECTION 2.
- 15 Said Act is further amended by striking from Section 23 of Part 1 the following:
- 16 "The salary of the judges of Division 1 of the State Court of Cobb County shall be
- 17 \$119,272.08 per annum.",
- and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 19 "The salary of the judges of Division 1 of the State Court of Cobb County shall be
- 20 \$124,042.96 per annum."
- 21 SECTION 3.
- 22 Said Act is further amended by striking in its entirety subsection (a) of Section 2-3 of Part
- 23 2 and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (a) to read as follows:

1 "(a) The salary of each associate judge shall be \$95,735.33 per annum to be paid in equal

- 2 monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County. The associate judges are designated
- 3 as full-time judges and may not engage in the private practice of law."

4 SECTION 4.

- 5 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 6 without such approval.

7 SECTION 4.

8 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
