A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 1 of Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame, so as change provisions
- 3 relating to the powers of the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame Board; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Subpart 1 of Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 8 Annotated, relating to the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame, is amended by striking Code
- 9 Section 50-12-72, relating to the purpose and function of the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame
- 10 Board, and Code Section 50-12-73, relating to facilities of the hall of fame, and inserting in
- 11 their place new Code sections to read as follows:
- *"*50-12-72.
- 13 (a) It shall be the main purpose and function of the board to promote and encourage the
- growth and public support of aviation within the state by honoring those, living or dead,
- who by extraordinary achievement or service have made outstanding and lasting
- 16 contributions to aviation in Georgia. Persons eligible for recognition in the Georgia
- 17 Aviation Hall of Fame shall include residents of the state whose achievements in or
- 18 contributions to aviation occurred within or outside the state and nonresidents whose
- achievements in or contributions to aviation occurred within the state. The board is
- authorized to conduct surveys and polls and to appoint committees to assist it in performing
- 21 its purpose and function.
- 22 (b) The board shall construct and maintain a facility and related attractions to house the
- 23 Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame which, with the approval of the federal government, shall
- be located at Robins Air Force Base in Houston County, Georgia.

1 (1) To have custody and control of any real property, or interest therein, located at

- 2 Robins Air Force Base in Houston County, Georgia, and acquired by the state through
- 3 <u>its State Properties Commission for the benefit of the board and to construct Georgia</u>
- 4 Aviation Hall of Fame buildings and facilities on that property;
- 5 (2) To contract with the Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission for the
- 6 construction of the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame, as provided for in Article 2 of
- 7 Chapter 17 of this title, or to contract with other authorities, departments, or agencies of
- 8 <u>the State of Georgia for the construction of the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame;</u>
- 9 (3) To acquire by purchase, gift, lease, or otherwise and to own, hold, improve, and use
- and to sell, convey, exchange, transfer, lease, sublease, and dispose of personal property
- of every kind and character or any interest therein for its purposes; and
- 12 (4) To operate, advertise, and promote the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame.
- 13 (b)(d) Without limiting the generality of subsection (a) of this Code section, it is
- specifically further provided that the board shall be authorized to establish a library and a
- 15 research archive program for purposes of education and research in the fields of aviation,
- aviation history, and related areas. The board shall be authorized to receive, catalog, and
- maintain documents, books, pictures, and other items for such purposes.

- 19 (a) With the approval of the federal government, the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame shall
- 20 be located in the Museum of Aviation at Robins Air Force Base in Houston County,
- 21 Georgia. The headquarters of the board shall be located in Houston County, Georgia. The
- 22 board may obtain such halls, rooms, quarters, and offices as it deems necessary for
- 23 conducting its affairs. The board is authorized to recognize and designate any existing or
- 24 proposed facility as a part of the hall of fame as may be appropriate.
- 25 (b) The Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame is designated as and shall be known as the Official
- 26 State of Georgia Repository for Aviation History."
- SECTION 2.
- 28 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 29 without such approval.
- 30 SECTION 3.
- 31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
