## A RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, the Fayette County High School Marching Band has established itself as one  
3 of the premier high school bands in the southeast; and
- 4 WHEREAS, continuing a tradition of excellence over the years, the band in the 1999-2000  
5 academic year garnered such distinctions as Sandy Creek Invitational Tournament Gold  
6 Grand Champions, Phenix City Invitational Marching Contest Grand Champions, and Peach  
7 State Marching Contest Grand Champion, and in the 2000-2001 academic year such awards  
8 as Sandy Creek Invitational Tournament Silver Grand Champion and Super Bowl of Sound  
9 Grand Champions, and the band received awards in its especially strong categories of drum  
10 major, percussion, and color guard; and
- 11 WHEREAS, as a crowning achievement, the band was honored in being chosen to represent  
12 Atlanta as members of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Band; and
