3 Nongoma, South Africa, and is a direct descendent of King Senzangakhona, the father of

4 King Shaka, who has been identified by experts as being one of the world's military legends,

5 a strategist, a nation builder, an unflappable and charismatic leader and founder of the Zulu

WHEREAS, on December 3, 1971, King Goodwill Zwelithini was formally crowned as the
king and has ruled as king since that time; and

9 WHEREAS, King Goodwill Zwelithini is widely respected as a ruler with the common touch

10 and is the constitutional monarch of the Kingdom of KwaZulu-Natal and rules over millions

11 of persons of Zulu heritage; and

12 WHEREAS, as the custodian of Zulu traditions and customs, he has revived cultural

13 functions and promoted respect for other cultures among the diverse populations living in

14 KwaZulu-Natal; and

WHEREAS, King Goodwill Zwelithini has supported educational leaders in their quest toimprove the quality of education for the Zulu nation; and

WHEREAS, King Goodwill Zwelithini is leading a cultural and trade delegation to Georgia
to promote tourism, economic development, education, and cultural exchange between his
citizens and those of the great State of Georgia.
