### A RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, Joshua Miller, a sixth grade student at Byron Middle School, was recently  
3 taking out the trash when he noticed that his sister had followed him; and
- 4 WHEREAS, assuming that his 18-month-old brother, Mark, had also followed him, Joshua  
5 began looking for his brother and found him floating in the family swimming pool; and
- 6 WHEREAS, reacting immediately, Joshua pulled his brother from the pool, saw that Mark  
7 was not breathing , and began administering CPR, which he had learned from reading and  
8 watching television; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Joshua's quick and unselfish reaction to his brother's circumstances clearly  
10 saved his brother's life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the citizens of Byron and the State of Georgia are justly proud of Joshua Miller  
12 and the outstanding example which he has provided to others by taking decisive action in a  
13 crisis situation and by saving the life of his brother.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 the members of this body recognize and commend Joshua Miller for his actions in saving the  
16 life of his brother and for his service as a positive role model for the citizens of this state.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
18 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Joshua Miller.
