

The Senate Transportation Committee offered the following substitute to SB 386:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 32-6-26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 weights of vehicles and loads, so as to change certain provisions relative to exemptions; to
3 provide an exemption for ready-mixed concrete; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 32-6-26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to weights of
8 vehicles and loads, is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (g) and inserting in
9 lieu thereof the following:

10 "(g)(1) The weight limitations provided for in this Code section, except the limitation in
11 subsections (f) and (h) of this Code section, may be exceeded on any public road within
12 this state which is not a national highway, or when making a pickup or delivery on any
13 public road of a county road system, without a permit when the load on any single axle
14 does not exceed 23,000 pounds and the maximum total gross weight of the vehicle and
15 load does not exceed 80,000 pounds when:

16 (A) Hauling forest products from the forest where cut to the owner's place of business,
17 plant, plantation, or residence;

18 (B) Hauling live poultry or cotton from a farm to a processing plant;

19 (C) Hauling feed from a feed mill to a farm;

20 (D) Hauling granite, either block or sawed for further processing, from the quarry to
21 a processing plant located in the same or an adjoining county; ~~or~~

22 (E) Hauling solid waste or recovered materials from points of generation to a solid
23 waste handling facility or other processing facility; or

24 (F) Hauling concrete that is in a freshly mixed and unhardened state for delivery to a
25 customer located in the same or an adjoining county."

SECTION 2.

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- 2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
