A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Article 11 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2	relating to miscellaneous provisions of uniform rules of the road, so as to change certain
3	provisions relating to drivers' duty to exercise due care and the allowance of proper use of
4	radios and mobile telephones; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Article 11 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8	miscellaneous provisions of uniform rules of the road, is amended by striking Code Section
9	40-6-241, relating to drivers' duty to exercise due care and the allowance of proper use of
10	radios and mobile telephones, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
11	"40-6-241.
12	A driver shall exercise due care in operating a motor vehicle on the highways of this
13	state and shall not engage in any actions which shall distract such driver from the safe
14	operation of such vehicle, provided that the proper use of a radio, citizens band radio, or
15	mobile telephone shall not be a violation of this Code section."
