A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of Norman Rogers, Jr., M.D., and expressing regret at his passing; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of Norman Rogers, Jr., M.D., late of Cairo, is received with
4 deep regret by this body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman of 70 years rendered his name dear
6 to the hearts of his family and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, he was an associate professor of surgery at Howard University and a
8 distinguished general surgeon specializing in thyroid and parathyroid surgery; his
9 achievements and contributions to the medical profession were recognized by many
10 including the Drew Scientific Forum of the National Medical Association, Howard
11 University Hospital, and the Science Gallery of Distinction of Florida A&M University; and
12 he was a veteran of the United States Air Force, having ranked as lieutenant commander; and

13 WHEREAS, his devotion to duty and commitment to serving others made his community
14 and this state and nation better places to live; and

15 WHEREAS, while in life he commanded the esteem of his fellow citizens, in his death we
16 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 honor the memory of Norman Rogers, Jr., M.D., and express their regret at his passing.
