A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the "Sharon Beasley-Teague Bridge"; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Honorable Sharon Beasley-Teague is an esteemed member of the Georgia
3 General Assembly representing District 58 in the House of Representatives; and
- 4 WHEREAS, for ten years she has served the interests of her constituents of the South Fulton
5 County area with great distinction and admirable dedication; and
- 6 WHEREAS, as a member of the House of Representatives where she serves as a member of
7 the Industrial Relations Committee and as secretary to both the Motor Vehicles Committee
8 and the Regulated Beverages Committee, she is singularly devoted to promoting and
9 enacting those legislative measures which will best serve the interests of the citizens of the
10 State of Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in addition to her service as a legislator, she is a member of the Southern
12 Christian Leadership Conference, the NAACP, the National Jewish Fund, Operation Bread
13 Basket, Head Start Ind., the United Youth Adult Conference, and the Christian Minister's
14 Alliance; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she is much beloved by the South Fulton County community which she
16 cherishes and to which she gives so much of her time and attention; and
- 17 WHEREAS, her positive and inspirational influence on the lives of her fellow citizens is
18 highly worthy of recognition.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 GEORGIA that this body designates the bridge located at Flat Shoals Road at I-85S in Fulton
21 County as the "Sharon Beasley-Teague Bridge."

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
2 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs so designating such bridge.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
4 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Honorable Sharon Beasley-Teague and
5 the Department of Transportation.
