- 1 To amend Code Section 31-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.** Code Section 31-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the 6 7 breast-feeding of babies, is amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting 8 in lieu thereof the following: "31-1-9. 9 10 The breast-feeding of a baby is an important and basic act of nurture to which every baby 11 has a right and which act must should be encouraged in the interests of maternal and child 12 health. A and family values, and in furtherance of this right, a mother may breast-feed her baby in any location, where the mother and baby are otherwise authorized to be, provided 13 14 the mother acts in a discreet and modest way."
