

House Bill 1379

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for election districts for the board of education of Douglas  
2 County, approved April 13, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4786), as amended, particularly by an Act  
3 approved March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3578), so as to provide for compensation of  
4 members; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing for election districts for the board of education of Douglas County,  
8 approved April 13, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4786), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
9 March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3578), is amended by striking subsection (h) of Section 1  
10 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11 "(h) The chairperson of the board of education shall be compensated in equal monthly  
12 installments from the general funds of the board of education the sum of 20 percent of the  
13 base salary for a superior court judge as set forth in O.C.G.A. Section 45-7-4. The vice  
14 chairperson of the board of education shall be compensated in equal monthly installments  
15 from the general funds of the board of education the sum of 18 percent of the base salary  
16 for a superior court judge as set forth in O.C.G.A. Section 45-7-4. The remaining board  
17 members shall be compensated in equal monthly installments from the general funds of the  
18 board of education the sum of 16 percent of the base salary for a superior court judge as set  
19 forth in O.C.G.A. Section 45-7-4. The members of the board of education shall be  
20 reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in carrying out approved board of education  
21 business while outside the county. All expenses so incurred shall be paid from the general  
22 funds of the board of education on a monthly basis."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which  
25 it is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

**SECTION 3.**

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
