A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Center for Puppetry Arts; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Center for Puppetry Arts was founded in Atlanta in 1978 by Vincent
3 Anthony; and

4 WHEREAS, the center is the largest organization in the United States dedicated to the art
5 form of puppetry and focuses on the areas of performance, museum, and education; and

6 WHEREAS, the center is recognized for the positive contributions it has made not only to
7 the Atlanta area, but to the entire state through its performances, exhibits, and workshops;

9 WHEREAS, the staff of the center generously provided their time, creativity, and artistic
10 talent to the production of "Play it Safe," a video produced by the Georgia Emergency
11 Management Agency in collaboration with First Lady Marie Barnes, to enhance the safety
12 of children in Georgia's preschools and child care facilities.
