WHEREAS, the Georgia Southern University Football Team has an outstanding tradition of excellence in the national collegiate sport of football and brought fame and honor to the university, students, and state as the NCAA 1-AA National Champions for 2000; and

6 WHEREAS, these terrific athletes earned the sixth national title for Georgia Southern, the

7 third in the last ten years and the second in as many years, and the 13-2 overall record is one

8 of the third-best seasons ever and the best since 1999, another 13-2 record season; and

10 year and the fifth championship ever, and the superior performance of these players and their

11 superb teamwork earned Head Coach Paul Johnson the AFCA Division I-AA Region II title

WHEREAS, the Eagles broke or tied 51 team or individual records in 2000; won more games (40) than any other NCAA Division I (A or AA) team in the nation during the last three seasons; and posted an all-time record of 34-6 in the NCAA Division I-AA playoffs, the top record in the history of the division.
