# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
public disclosure of records, so as to exempt the name and identity of victims of sexual
assault from disclosure under the Open Records Act; to provide for related matters; to repeal
conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### 6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public disclosure of records, is amended by inserting after paragraph (4.1) in subsection (a) a new 8 9 paragraph (4.2) to read as follows: 10 ''(4.2) Records that would reveal the name or identity of a victim of sexual assault or 11 attempted sexual assault to include, but not be limited to, rape, statutory rape, child 12 molestation, aggravated child molestation, enticing a child for indecent purposes, 13 aggravated sodomy, sexual battery, aggravated sexual battery, and criminal attempt to 14 commit such crimes; provided, however, that a record which has been redacted to remove 15 or fully obscure the name and identifying information of any such victim may be disclosed if it is not otherwise excluded from disclosure by law;". 16
