## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Andrew Wallace; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Andrew Wallace of Troop 407 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most  
3 distinguished order conferred by the Boy Scouts of America, and his Eagle Court of Honor  
4 will be held on January 28, 2001, in Hayesville, North Carolina; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for this highest award in scouting must complete a rigorous program  
6 of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques; and

7 WHEREAS, he has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various  
8 special skills imparted through the Boy Scout program, passed his Eagle Scout board of  
9 review, and completed a challenging service project of benefit to his community; and

11 WHEREAS, Andrew arranged with the U.S. Forestry Service to reconstruct steps and a  
12 walkway along a trail that placed the safety of hikers at risk, and he completed the project  
13 while preserving the natural rustic beauty of the forest and the land; and

14 WHEREAS, he has exhibited a commitment to the scouting principles of honesty, fairness,  
15 and service to community and has consistently conducted himself in a manner becoming an  
16 Eagle Scout.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body recognize and commend Andrew Wallace on attaining the  
19 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
