A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for a homestead exemption from all City of Jonesboro ad valorem taxes for
- 2 municipal purposes in the amount of \$60,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for
- 3 certain residents of that city; to provide for definitions; to specify the terms and conditions
- 4 of the exemption and the procedures relating thereto; to provide for applicability; to provide
- 5 for a referendum, effective dates, and automatic repeal; to provide for related matters; to
- 6 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 (a) As used in this Act, the term:
- 10 (1) "Ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes" means all ad valorem taxes for municipal
- purposes levied by, for, or on behalf of the City of Jonesboro except for taxes to pay
- interest on and to retire bonded indebtedness.
- 13 (2) "Homestead" means homestead as defined and qualified in Code Section 48-5-40 of
- the O.C.G.A.
- 15 (b) Each resident of the City of Jonesboro is granted an exemption on that person's
- 16 homestead from all City of Jonesboro ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount
- of \$60,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead. The value of the property in excess
- 18 of such exempted amount shall remain subject to taxation.
- 19 (c) A person shall not receive the homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this
- section unless the person or person's agent files an application with the governing authority
- 21 of the City of Jonesboro, or the designee thereof, giving such information relative to
- 22 receiving such exemption as will enable the governing authority of the City of Jonesboro, or
- 23 the designee thereof, to make a determination as to whether such owner is entitled to such
- 24 exemption.
- 25 (d) The governing authority of the City of Jonesboro, or the designee thereof, shall provide
- 26 affidavit and application forms for the exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section

1 which shall require such information as may be necessary to determine the initial and

- 2 continuing eligibility of the owner for the exemption.
- 3 (e) The exemption shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code Section 48-5-50.1 of
- 4 the O.C.G.A. The exemption shall be automatically renewed from year to year as long as the
- 5 owner occupies the residence as a homestead. After a person has filed the proper application,
- 6 as provided in subsection (c) of this section, it shall not be necessary to make application
- 7 thereafter for any year and the exemption shall continue to be allowed to such person. It
- 8 shall be the duty of any person granted the homestead exemption under subsection (b) of this
- 9 section to notify the governing authority of the City of Jonesboro, or the designee thereof,
- in the event that person for any reason becomes ineligible for that exemption.
- 11 (f) The exemption granted by this Act shall not apply to or affect state ad valorem taxes,
- 12 county ad valorem taxes for county purposes, or county school district ad valorem taxes for
- 13 educational purposes. The homestead exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section
- shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any other homestead exemption applicable to ad
- 15 valorem taxes for municipal purposes.
- 16 (g) The exemption granted by subsection (b) of this section shall apply to all taxable years
- beginning on or after January 1, 2003.

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the municipal
- 20 election superintendent of City of Jonesboro shall call and conduct an election as provided
- 21 in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of Jonesboro
- 22 for approval or rejection. The municipal election superintendent shall conduct that election
- 23 on the date and in conjunction with the 2002 general primary and shall issue the call and
- 24 conduct that election as provided by general law. The municipal superintendent shall cause
- 25 the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately
- 26 preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Clayton County. The ballot shall have
- 27 written or printed thereon the words:
- 28 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which provides a homestead exemption from all
- 29 City of Jonesboro ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount
- 30 () NO of \$60,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents of that
- 31 city?"
- 32 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons
- desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes
- cast on such question are for approval of the Act, Section 1 of this Act shall become of full
- 35 force and effect on January 1, 2003. If the Act is not so approved or if the election is not
- 36 conducted as provided in this section, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and

1 this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately following

- 2 that election date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Jonesboro. It
- 3 shall be the municipal election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the
- 4 Secretary of State.

5 SECTION 3.

- 6 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
- 7 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

8 SECTION 4.

9 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
